CHAPTER 28

(Senate Bill 20)

AN ACT concerning

Department of Health and Mental Hygiene – Definition of Secretary

FOR the purpose of altering the definition of Secretary for certain purposes relating to the Food, Drugs, and Cosmetics Title of the Health – General Article.

BY adding to

Article – Health – General

Section 21-101(o)

Annotated Code of Maryland

(1990 Replacement Volume and 1990 Supplement)

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article – Health – General

21-101.

(O) "SECRETARY" MEANS FOR THE PURPOSES OF SUBTITLES 1, 2, 3, 4, 8, AND 11 OF THIS TITLE, THE SECRETARY OF HEALTH AND MENTAL HYGIENE OR THE SECRETARY'S DESIGNEE.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1991.

CHAPTER 29

(Senate Bill 24)

AN ACT concerning

Disabled Individuals – Substituted Consent

FOR the purpose of allowing certain relatives of a disabled individual to provide substituted consent for medical or dental care and treatment of a disabled individual.
