

(8) ["Peddler" means any person, firm, or corporation having no storage facility other than trucks who purchases motor vehicle fuel from a licensed motor vehicle fuel dealer, special fuel seller, jobber, or heating oil distributor for resale or redistribution] "PRODUCER" MEANS A COMPANY THAT ENGAGES, OR HAS AN AGENT, PARENT COMPANY, SUBSIDIARY OR JOINT VENTURE THAT ENGAGES, IN EXTRACTING CRUDE OIL FROM THE EARTH.

(9) "Major brand" means the primary trade name or trademark most commonly associated with and identified with a [manufacturer and] PRODUCER OR refiner's retail service station.

(10) "Secondary brand" means a trade name or trademark, other than a major brand, used to identify a [manufacturer and] PRODUCER OR refiner's retail service station.

(11) "Unbranded" means [an independent retail service station dealer, jobber, heating oil distributor, motor fuel wholesaler, or peddler marketing gasoline or special fuels under its own brand, trade name, or trademark other than those of a manufacturer and refiner, or any subsidiary thereof] A BRAND OTHER THAN THE PRIMARY OR SECONDARY BRAND, TRADE NAME, OR TRADEMARK OTHER THAN THAT OF A PRODUCER, REFINER, OR ANY SUBSIDIARY THEREOF.

(13) "REFINER" MEANS A PERSON WHO MAKES MOTOR FUEL FROM CRUDE OIL BY CHANGING THE PHYSICAL OR CHEMICAL CHARACTERISTICS OF THE CRUDE OIL.

(14) "SPECIAL FUEL RETAILER" MEANS A PERSON ACQUIRING SPECIAL FUEL IN BULK, TO BE SOLD AT RETAIL FOR USE OTHER THAN AS A MOTOR FUEL.

(15) "TERMINAL OPERATOR" MEANS A PERSON OPERATING A FACILITY WHERE MOTOR FUEL IS STORED IN BULK FOR FURTHER DISTRIBUTION.

157B.

(a) The Comptroller of the Treasury shall administer the provisions of this subtitle. For this purpose, he may promulgate such rules and regulations as may be necessary for the proper administration and enforcement of this subtitle. He shall establish by regulation minimum specifications for the various gasoline and special fuel products marketed in this State consistent with the general practices of other states and the petroleum industry. When such specifications are established, the supplier of the gasoline and special fuel products to the retail service station dealer shall [compound the product stored by the dealer so that it meets] ENSURE THAT THE PRODUCTS MEET specifications. Any analysis of products under this subtitle shall be conducted by using any testing method approved by the Comptroller, including those of the American Society for Testing and Materials. Notwithstanding any provision in this subtitle to the contrary, the Comptroller is not required to collect, inspect, test, analyze, or establish
