CHAPTER 41

(Senate Bill 100)

AN ACT concerning

State Boards of Audiologists and Speech-Language Pathologists - Requirements for Licensure

FOR the purpose of altering a certain qualification for licensure by the State Board of Examiners for Audiologists and the State Board of Examiners for Speech-Language Pathologists.

BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,

Article - Health Occupations

Section 2-305(a) and 20-305(a)

Annotated Code of Maryland

(1991 Replacement Volume)

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article - Health Occupations

2-305.

(a) The Board may waive any of the qualifications required for a license under this title for an individual who:

(1) Is of good moral character;

(2) Pays the application fee required by the Board under § 2-303 of this subtitle; and

(3) [(i)] Holds the certificate of clinical competence in audiology of the American Speech-Language-Hearing Association and meets the practice requirements established by the Board[; or

(ii) Was engaged actively in the practice of audiology in this State on July 1, 1972].
