the status of any capital projects having a proposed programmatic change which will result in an increase of 10% of either the original cost estimate or the total project square footage as established in the approved program. No increase in excess of 10% of either a project's original cost estimate or total project square footage may be approved or implemented prior to review and comment by the budget committees, or the passage of 45 days from the receipt of the quarterly report containing the proposed modification(s).
