- (a) Subject to the provisions of this section, the Board may waive any examination requirement of this subtitle for an individual who is licensed to practice engineering in another state.
 - (b) The Board may grant a waiver under this section only if the applicant:
 - (1) is of good character and reputation;
- (2) pays to the Board [the] A license fee OF \$100 IN LIEU OF ANY FEE required under § 14-312 of this subtitle; and
- (3) provides adequate evidence that, at the time the applicant was licensed by the other state, the applicant met requirements that were equivalent to those then required by the laws of this State.
