

Article 56 - Licenses

112AB.

(a) Except as provided in subsection (f) of this section, the Commission may issue a license to conduct, hold or give professional kick boxing, boxing and sparring or wrestling matches and exhibitions:

(1) At no fee, to:

- (i) The United States of America Amateur Boxing Federation; and
- (ii) The Young Men's Christian Association; OR

(2) To any person, club, corporation or association to act as a promoter, on payment of an annual license fee of [\$100; or

(3) For an individual show, on payment of a license fee of \$25] \$300.

(b) The Commission may issue an annual license to:

(1) Act as referee of such matches, on payment of the annual license fee of [\$10] \$25;

(2) Participate, as contestant, in such matches, on the payment of an annual license fee of [\$10] \$20;

(3) Act as second in such matches, on payment of an annual license fee of [\$10] \$20;

(4) Act as manager of such matches, on payment of an annual license fee of [\$15; and] \$50;

(5) Act as a matchmaker, on payment of an annual license fee of [\$25] \$50;

AND  
(6) ACT AS A JUDGE, ON PAYMENT OF AN ANNUAL LICENSE FEE OF \$25.

(c) (1) No unlicensed person shall act as referee, JUDGE, promoter, matchmaker, manager or second of any professional kick boxing, boxing, sparring, or wrestling match or participate in a match as a contestant without obtaining a license.

(2) No person, club, corporation or association may permit any unlicensed person to act or participate in a match in violation of paragraph (1) of this subsection.

(d) Every license shall be subject to the regulations of the Commission.

(e) An applicant for a license under this section shall submit to the Commission a written application that contains:

(1) A statement that shows that the applicant is entitled to receive a license;
