SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article - Courts and Judicial Proceedings

[11–103.

- (a) A judgment by confession where the amount is not specified in the judgment is interlocutory.
- (b) If a judgment by confession for an unspecified amount has been entered, the court shall, on motion of the plaintiff, order an inquisition or extend the judgment as provided by Rule 648.]

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1991.

(Senate Bill 371)

AN ACT concerning

Annual Corrective Bill
