

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

**Article - Courts and Judicial Proceedings**

[11-103.

(a) A judgment by confession where the amount is not specified in the judgment is interlocutory.

(b) If a judgment by confession for an unspecified amount has been entered, the court shall, on motion of the plaintiff, order an inquisition or extend the judgment as provided by Rule 648.]

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1991.

**CHAPTER 55**

**(Senate Bill 371)**

AN ACT concerning

**Annual Corrective Bill**

FOR the purpose of correcting certain errors and omissions in certain articles of the Annotated Code and in certain uncodified laws; clarifying language; codifying certain conflicting acts; providing that with certain exceptions this Act is not intended to affect any law other than to correct technical errors; repealing certain obsolete provisions of law relating to the Division of Statutory Revision; codifying certain provisions of law relating to salaries of certain elected officials; amending certain provisions of law relating to certain reporting requirements; codifying and revising certain provisions of law relating to certain committees, commissions, and task forces; requiring the publishers of the Annotated Code to make certain changes in the Code to effectuate certain termination provisions; renumbering certain sections of the Annotated Code; providing for the effect and construction of certain provisions of this Act; and making this Act an emergency measure.
