(c) As to any bonds issued under the provisions of this section for the purpose of providing funds for the construction, remodeling, enlargement or replacement of any office or operating building or buildings, the WSSC shall annually determine the amount necessary to meet the principal and interest requirements of such bonds, and shall set aside annually for such purpose so much of the receipts from water service charges, sewer usage charges, house connection charges and any other charges imposed by the WSSC as the WSSC shall determine to be fair and equitable to be so set aside, and the amounts of such receipts so set aside shall be deducted from the amount which the WSSC has determined to be necessary to be raised by direct taxation under the provisions of [Section 6 of Chapter 122 of the Laws of Maryland of 1918, as amended,] § 4–105 of this title, upon certification to the County Council of Montgomery County and the County Council of Prince George's County.
