

Article 31 – Debt – Public

30.

(a) (3) “Bonds in registered form” means bonds issued in any form qualifying as “registered form” within the meaning of [Section 103] §§ 103 AND 149 of the Internal Revenue Code [of 1954], as amended, and any regulations promulgated or proposed thereunder, as amended from time to time.

Article 33 – Election Code

8-4.

(a) Not less than sixty-five days before a general election at which the voters elect the President of the United States, the State Administrative Board of Election Laws shall certify to the board of each county and of the City of Baltimore, the name, party affiliation and residence of each person nominated for the office, as specified in the certificates of [nominations] NOMINATION issued by the State Administrative Board of Election Laws and the name and residence of each appellate judge at an election for his continuance in office.

9-1.

(a) The times designated in subsections (b) and (c) of this section for declining nominations and for withdrawal of certificates of candidacy and for board offices to be open are mandatory and the provisions of these subsections shall also be applicable to municipal elections in Baltimore City. The provisions of these subsections shall not be applicable to elections pursuant to [§ 4A-1] § 22-1(B) of this article, and any right of withdrawal in such elections shall be limited to whatever is set forth in the Governor’s proclamation, provided, however, that said proclamation by the Governor must contain a provision which allows any person who has filed a certificate of candidacy pursuant to § 22-1(b) of this article to withdraw such certificate within two days after the final filing date as established in § 4A-3 of this article.
