#### Article 73B – Pensions

150.

All of the assets of this pension system shall be credited, according to the purpose for which they are held, to the following funds:

- (i) The Annuity Savings Fund;
- (ii) The Accumulation Fund; or
- (iii) The Expense Fund.

[(1)] (2) (g) Whenever an audit of the records of a school system, public library, or educational institution reveals that the system, library, or institution owes money to the Accumulation Fund of the Teachers' Pension System, any delinquent payment may be collected by the Maryland State Retirement Agency in the manner set forth in §§ 5-202.1, 16-403.3, and 23-403.1 of the Education Article for recovery of delinquent social security payments.
