

**Article 83A – Department of Economic and Employment Development**

5-114.

(a) Except as otherwise provided in this section, in exercising its corporate powers, the Corporation is exempt from the provisions of Articles [15A,] 41[,] and 78A of the Code; § 10-507 of the State Government Article; and § 2-105, Title 2, Subtitles 2, 4, and 5, Titles 3 and 4, Title 6, Subtitle 1, Title 7, Subtitles 1, 2, and 3, §§ 8-127, 8-128, and 8-129, Part V of Title 8, Subtitle 1, and Title 10, and Division II of the State Finance and Procurement Article, and may carry out its corporate purposes without obtaining the consent of any department, board, or agency of the State.

Error: Obsolete cross-reference in Article 83A, § 5-114(a).

Occurred: As a result of Chapter 11, Acts of 1985, which enacted the State Finance and Procurement Article. Provisions that formerly appeared in Article 15A from which the Economic Development Corporation is exempt now are codified as the enumerated provisions in the State Finance and Procurement Article.

**Article 83B – Department of Housing and Community Development**

(a) The following agencies, boards, commissions, councils, corporations, authorities, trusts, and divisions shall be included within the Department:

- (4) Division of Housing [Insurance] CREDIT ASSURANCE;
