Title 5.

Limitations [and Prohibited Actions], PROHIBITED ACTIONS, AND IMMUNITIES

Subtitle 1. Limitations

5-101.

A civil action at law shall be filed within three years from the date it accrues unless another provision of the Code provides a different period of time within which an action shall be commenced.

Subtitle 3. Prohibited Actions AND IMMUNITIES

5-301.

The provisions governing actions for breach of promise to marry and for alienation of affections are found in Title 3, Subtitle 1 of the Family Law Article.

### Article - Education

3-701.

(f) (1) Each elected member serves for a term of 4 years beginning on December 1 after the member's election and until a successor is elected and qualifies. The terms of elected members are staggered as required by the terms of the members serving on the County Board as of July 1, 1978 so that 4 members are elected in gubernatorial election years and [4] 3 members are elected in presidential election years.
