- (a) This section does not apply to any project involving the construction of a dwelling unit or other [nonwater] NON-WATER dependent structure on a pier located on State or private wetlands in Prince George's County.
- (b) (1) Except as provided in paragraphs (2) and (3) of this subsection, notwithstanding any other provision of law, the Board of Public Works may not issue a license under this title for any project involving the construction of a dwelling unit or other [nonwater] NON-WATER dependent structure on a pier located on State wetlands.
- (2) This section does not prohibit or restrict the Board of Public Works from issuing a license for a project involving the construction of a dwelling unit or other [nonwater] NON-WATER dependent structure on a pier located within the Critical Area that was issued a permit by the Secretary on or before January 1, 1989.
