(c) In addition to any administrative penalty provided in this title, violation of any regulation or restriction adopted by any unit within the Department of Natural Resources [or the Department of Health and Mental Hygiene] pursuant to the provisions of this title is a misdemeanor and is punishable as provided in subsections (a) and (b) of this section.

Occurred: As a result of Ch. 240, Acts of 1982 which transferred certain provisions relative to the authority of the Department of Health and Mental Hygiene over certain environmental laws from Title 8 of the Natural Resources Article to the former Health - Environmental Article.

9-104.

(a) This section does not apply to any project involving the construction of a dwelling unit or other [nonwater] NON-WATER dependent structure on a pier located on State or private wetlands in Prince George's County.

(b) (1) Except as provided in paragraphs (2) and (3) of this subsection, notwithstanding any other provision of law, the Board of Public Works may not issue a license under this title for any project involving the construction of a dwelling unit or other [nonwater] NON-WATER dependent structure on a pier located on State wetlands.

(2) This section does not prohibit or restrict the Board of Public Works from issuing a license for a project involving the construction of a dwelling unit or other [nonwater] NON-WATER dependent structure on a pier located within the Critical Area that was issued a permit by the Secretary on or before January 1, 1989.
