**Article 5 – Calvert County**

11-204.

(a) The Authority is a body corporate and politic and is constituted a public instrumentality of the county. The exercise by the authority of the powers conferred by the provisions of this subtitle shall be deemed to be the performance of essential governmental functions. The authority consists of 9 members, appointed for 3 year terms by the county commissioners, subject to the approval of the county delegation to the general assembly. The members shall include:

(6) An owner, operator, or manager of a local commercial business[,];
