[(c)] The county commissioners may secure the loan by placing a lien on the affected property and may subordinate said lien to later liens if in their discretion the interests of the county are reasonably protected.

- [(d)] To be eligible under the sewerage assistance program, a person shall:
 - (1) Be a resident of Calvert County;
 - (2) Be the owner or owners of the affected property; and
- (3) Have an income level that is set by the county commissioners to qualify for a loan [(b)(1)] above or an income level that is set by the county commissioners to qualify for a loan under (b)(2) above UNDER § 16-102(1) OR § 16-102(2) OF THIS SUBTITLE.

16-105.

[(e)] The county commissioners may enact ordinances to carry out the water and sewerage assistance program.

(a) The Maryland [department of employment and training] DEPARTMENT OF ECONOMIC AND EMPLOYMENT DEVELOPMENT shall provide the necessary office space and clerical help in order to operate a full-time office of the [state department of employment and training] DEPARTMENT OF ECONOMIC AND EMPLOYMENT DEVELOPMENT. This office shall be located in Prince Frederick.
