

Public Works. The Secretary shall submit, SUBJECT TO § 2-1312 OF THE STATE GOVERNMENT ARTICLE, a copy of the documentation with respect to specific recruiting or retention issues or other issues warranting an increase made in accordance with this subparagraph and approved by the Board of Public Works, to the Department of Fiscal Services, SUBJECT TO § 2-1312 OF THE STATE GOVERNMENT ARTICLE.

#### **Article 78 – Public Service Commission Law**

60.

The Commission may conduct such proceedings as it may deem desirable with respect to proposed amendments to any law which in its judgment would affect the public interest in any aspect of the business of any public service company, and may recommend or prepare legislation as to any matter within or related to its jurisdiction. Upon request by the Governor, or the General Assembly or either house thereof, the Commission shall conduct such proceedings, and, SUBJECT TO § 2-1312 OF THE STATE GOVERNMENT ARTICLE, report its conclusions to the person or body at whose request the proceedings were undertaken.

#### **Article 78B – Racing Commission**

(d) Each subdivision which is eligible to receive funds under subsection (c) of this section shall submit a written report to the Comptroller and, SUBJECT TO § 2-1312 OF THE STATE GOVERNMENT ARTICLE, the Department of Fiscal Services. The report shall be submitted on or before November 1 of each year, and shall contain the following information:

(1) A complete accounting of the actual purpose for which any such funds were expended or committed during the prior fiscal year ending June 30;

(2) A complete accounting of the funds appropriated in the budget of the subdivision for the current fiscal year, and of the intended use of further payments of such funds including the relationship of such future use to the presence of a racetrack. In the event that a future use will involve expenditure or commitment of such funds over a period of more than one year, the accounting of intended use shall include a schedule reflecting the annual amount to be expended or committed for each year through the completion of the intended use;

(3) A certification from the fiscal officer of the jurisdiction that any and all such funds will be held by the subdivision in a special account, and will be used only for the purposes specified in the report;

(4) A description of the procedures used by the subdivision to select the projects to be included in the accounting of intended use required under item (2) of this subsection, including the methods of solicitation and degree of participation in those procedures by the public; and
