- (ii) Require the governing boards of public institutions of higher education to submit plans, reports, and data, in the format and using such forms as the Commission prescribes; and
  - (iii) Evaluate the effectiveness of institutional efforts and methods.

Each year, the Commission shall submit a report to the Governor and, SUBJECT TO § 2-1312 OF THE STATE GOVERNMENT ARTICLE, the General Assembly of Maryland addressing the status of the College Preparation Intervention Program. 12-105.

- (d) (1) All income of the University shall be deposited:
  - (i) In the State treasury; or
  - (ii) As the State Treasurer directs.
- (2) By an approved budget amendment, the University may spend, or encumber, within the fiscal year in which they are received, revenues received in excess of those estimated for any fiscal year.
  - (3) All unexpended or unencumbered balances of the University's revenues:
- (i) Shall be reported to the Comptroller at the end of the fiscal year for which the appropriation was made;
- (ii) Do not revert to the general treasury of the State at the end of each fiscal year; and
- (iii) Shall be available for expenditure through an appropriation contained in a budget bill or through an approved budget amendment.
- (4) The provisions of this subsection may not be interpreted in any way that would diminish the authority of the Board of Regents under § 12–104(b) of this article.
- (5) The interest or other income from the investment of any funds of the University shall be credited to the University, provided that any interest estimated to be earned on the State appropriation must be offset by an equivalent reduction in State General Fund support, and such amount will be reported annually, SUBJECT TO § 2–1312 OF THE STATE GOVERNMENT ARTICLE, to the General Assembly.

(h) (1) The Board of Directors shall prepare an annual report describing operations of the Medical System Corporation in the immediately preceding fiscal year, which shall be delivered to the Board of Regents, the Governor, and, SUBJECT TO § 2–1312 OF THE STATE GOVERNMENT ARTICLE, the General Assembly as soon as practicable following the close of its fiscal year.
