(e) (1) A system shall maintain records identifying the sources and amounts of payments used to support:

(i) The auxiliary facilities; and

(ii) The academic facilities authorized under the requirements of this subtitle.

(2) A system shall report:

(i) By September 1 to the Board of Public Works and, SUBJECT TO § 2-1312 OF THE STATE GOVERNMENT ARTICLE, to the Department of Fiscal Services, the information for the prior fiscal year required under paragraph (1) of this subsection; and

(ii) By December 1, SUBJECT TO § 2-1312 OF THE STATE GOVERNMENT ARTICLE, to the Department of Fiscal Services, the anticipated sources and amounts of payments required for the next fiscal year for:

1. Auxiliary facilities; and

2. Academic facilities authorized under the requirements of this subtitle.

(d) The Commission shall update the plan developed under subsection (c) of this section by July 1 of each year and shall report any findings and recommendations resulting from the annual update to the Governor, the appropriate State agencies, and, SUBJECT TO § 2-1312 OF THE STATE GOVERNMENT ARTICLE, the Legislative Policy Committee of the General Assembly.

The Department shall submit an annual report on the Attendant Care Program, SUBJECT TO § 2-1312 OF THE STATE GOVERNMENT ARTICLE, to the Legislative Policy Committee of the State legislature by September 1 each year. These reports shall include demographic, disability, and cost effectiveness data.

(b) (4) (i) The Commission may not accept funds from an affiliated foundation unless the fiscal affairs of the affiliated foundation are audited annually by an independent certified public accountant.

(ii) The independent certified public accountant shall send copies of each annual audit report to the Commission and, SUBJECT TO § 2-1312 OF THE STATE GOVERNMENT ARTICLE, to the Department of Fiscal Services.
