

**Article - Environment**

3-304.

(a) The Committee shall:

(1) Receive reports of progress, problems, and proposed plans for attaining and maintaining State environmental noise standards from each agency that is represented on the Committee;

(2) Evaluate the adequacy of existing and proposed efforts to attain and maintain State environmental noise standards;

(3) Review the relationship of State noise control rules and regulations with other environmental laws, rules, regulations, standards, and programs;

(4) Recommend new or revised noise control rules, regulations, or legislation; and

(5) Submit an annual report to the State Council on the environment and, SUBJECT TO § 2-1312 OF THE STATE GOVERNMENT ARTICLE, the General Assembly.

6-701.

(a) The Secretary shall:

(1) Accept from physicians reports on occupational diseases;

(2) Study occupational diseases and means to prevent and control the diseases; and

(3) Submit to the General Assembly, SUBJECT TO § 2-1312 OF THE STATE GOVERNMENT ARTICLE, recommendations to prevent and control these diseases.

9-351.

(a) The Secretary shall report on or before January 15 of each year to the Governor and, SUBJECT TO § 2-1312 OF THE STATE GOVERNMENT ARTICLE, THE General Assembly on the status of the Water Pollution Control Fund.

9-1702.

(e) Beginning on January 1, 1990, and biannually thereafter, the Office shall, in coordination with the Maryland Environmental Service, study and report to the Governor and, SUBJECT TO § 2-1312 OF THE STATE GOVERNMENT ARTICLE, the General Assembly on:

(1) The availability of local, national, and international markets for recycling materials;
