

(1) the amount specified by the Board of Public Works may be transferred from the account to the appropriate annuity bond account to supplement the specified authorization; and

(2) a report on the use of the moneys shall be submitted, SUBJECT TO § 2-1312 OF THE STATE GOVERNMENT ARTICLE, to the Legislative Policy Committee of the General Assembly.

(h) By January 1 of each year, the Secretaries of State Planning and General Services shall submit a report, SUBJECT TO § 2-1312 OF THE STATE GOVERNMENT ARTICLE, to the General Assembly on the moneys:

- (1) appropriated to the Fund;
- (2) authorized for expenditure from the Fund; and
- (3) expended from the Fund.

(b) (1) Annually, the Board shall submit to the Governor a report that:

(i) contains an itemized statement of the estimated State revenues from all sources for the fiscal year following the fiscal year in which the report is made; and

(ii) includes any recommendations of the Board.

(2) The Governor shall send the report of the Board, SUBJECT TO § 2-1312 OF THE STATE GOVERNMENT ARTICLE, to the General Assembly.

(c) (3) The Secretary shall send a copy of each report under this subsection, SUBJECT TO § 2-1312 OF THE STATE GOVERNMENT ARTICLE, to the Director of the Department of Fiscal Services.
