- (c) (1) Subject to the limitations described in paragraph (2) of this subsection, the Authority may make any contracts and agreements necessary or incidental to the exercise of its powers and performance of its duties.
- (2) Not less than 30 days before entering into any contract or agreement to acquire or construct a revenue-producing transportation facilities project, the Authority shall provide, SUBJECT TO § 2-1312 OF THE STATE GOVERNMENT ARTICLE, the Legislative Policy Committee and the Department of Fiscal Services with information on the proposed contract or agreement.

(b) [The] SUBJECT TO § 2-1312 OF THE STATE GOVERNMENT ARTICLE, THE Secretary of Transportation and the Secretary of the Environment shall furnish a joint report, within 30 days after the date Congress modifies the provisions of the Federal Clean Air Act, to the Legislative Policy Committee, the Senate Judicial Proceedings Committee, and the House Environmental Matters Committee outlining the status of changes in the Federal Clean Air Act as of that date and all other related and pertinent information.
