

(V) IDENTIFICATION OF SPECIFIC MANAGEMENT MEASURES THAT COULD BE ADOPTED BY STATE AND LOCAL GOVERNMENT AGENCIES, INCLUDING MEASURES TO CONTROL THE CUMULATIVE IMPACTS OF GROWTH AND DEVELOPMENT.

(3) PREPARE A REPORT SUMMARIZING ITS FINDINGS AND RECOMMENDATIONS.

(G) THE TASK FORCE SHALL SUBMIT ITS FINDINGS AND RECOMMENDATIONS TO THE GOVERNOR, THE GOVERNOR'S COMMISSION ON GROWTH IN THE CHESAPEAKE BAY REGION, AND, SUBJECT TO § 2-1312 OF THE STATE GOVERNMENT ARTICLE, THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY ON OR BEFORE SEPTEMBER 1, 1991.

Article - State Government

Subtitle 10A. MISCELLANEOUS Statutory Committees [of Limited Duration]

2-10A-01. CHESAPEAKE BAY CRITICAL AREAS.

(A) THERE IS A JOINT COMMITTEE ON CHESAPEAKE BAY CRITICAL AREAS.

(B) (1) THE COMMITTEE CONSISTS OF 10 MEMBERS.

(2) OF THE 10 MEMBERS:

(I) 5 SHALL BE MEMBERS OF THE SENATE APPOINTED BY THE PRESIDENT OF THE SENATE; AND

(II) 5 SHALL BE MEMBERS OF THE HOUSE OF DELEGATES APPOINTED BY THE SPEAKER OF THE HOUSE.

(C) THE MEMBERS OF THE COMMITTEE SERVE AT THE PLEASURE OF THE PRESIDING OFFICER WHO APPOINTED THEM.

(D) THE PRESIDENT AND THE SPEAKER SHALL JOINTLY APPOINT A SENATOR AND A DELEGATE EACH TO SERVE AS COCHAIRMAN.

(E) THE DEPARTMENT OF LEGISLATIVE REFERENCE SHALL PROVIDE STAFF ASSISTANCE TO THE COMMITTEE.

(F) THE CHESAPEAKE BAY CRITICAL AREA COMMISSION SHALL MEET WITH THE COMMITTEE PERIODICALLY AS THE COMMITTEE REQUESTS TO REVIEW DEVELOPMENT AND IMPLEMENTATION OF THE CRITERIA FOR PROGRAM DEVELOPMENT.
