- (7) Investigating sources of financial and other assistance that may be available to save the lighthouses; and
- (8) Promoting a cooperative dialogue with other jurisdictions toward the preservation and restoration of lighthouses along the Atlantic seaboard.
- (d) The members of the Commission shall select a chairperson from the membership.
- (e) The Commission shall report its findings and recommendations to the Governor and, consistent with § 2-1312 of the State Government Article, to the General Assembly by July 1, 1991, and thereafter terminate its existence.
- (f) Staff for the Commission shall be provided by the Department of Legislative Reference and the Maryland Historical Trust.]

Chapter 129 of the Acts of 1990

[SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That:

- (1) There is an Interdepartmental Task Force on Preservation of State Streams.
 - (2) The Task Force shall be composed of:
- (i) 1 member of the House of Delegates, appointed by the Speaker of the House, and 1 member of the Senate of Maryland, appointed by the President of the Senate;
- (ii) 1 representative of the Department of Natural Resources, appointed by the Secretary of Natural Resources;
- (iii) 1 representative of the Maryland Department of Agriculture, appointed by the Secretary of Agriculture;
- (iv) 1 representative of the University of Maryland with expertise in environmental issues, appointed by the Chancellor;
- (v) 1 representative of the Department of the Environment, appointed by the Secretary of the Environment;
- (vi) 1 representative of the State Highway Administration of the Department of Transportation, appointed by the Secretary of Transportation;
- (vii) 1 representative of the Office of State Planning, appointed by the Director of the Office;
