

(n) (1) The Sheriff of Harford County shall not have employment outside of that position, and shall receive a salary of:

- (i) \$52,000 in 1991;
- (ii) \$55,000 in 1992;
- (iii) \$58,000 in 1993; and

(iv) \$60,000 in 1994 and thereafter. He shall appoint the number of deputies at the compensation provided in the county budget.

(2) The Sheriff may appoint as a special deputy sheriff:

- (i) The chief of police of a Harford County municipality; or
- (ii) A member of the police force of a Harford County municipality who is certified by the Maryland Police Training Commission.

(3) A special deputy sheriff appointed under this subsection is not an employee of Harford County.

(4) The Sheriff of Harford County shall have the authority to formulate and administer a plan that includes the method of supervision to use inmates the Sheriff deems eligible and selects to perform, under the supervision of State, county, or municipal employees, tasks the Sheriff assigns within the county or any incorporated municipality within the county.

**Article - Health - General**

15-127.

(a) In this section the following words have the meanings indicated.

- (1) "Child" means any individual under the age of 18 years.
- (2) "Initial assessment" includes:
  - (i) A psychological evaluation;
  - (ii) Parental interview; and
  - (iii) Medical evaluation.

(3) (i) For purposes of this section, "Sexual abuse" means any act that involves sexual molestation or exploitation of a child whether or not the sexual molestation or exploitation of the child is by a parent or other person who has permanent
