**Article – State Finance and Procurement**

14-306.

On or before December 31 of each year, the Governor’s Office of Minority Affairs shall submit to the Legislative Policy Committee a report summarizing the information that Office receives under § 14-305(b) of this subtitle.

**DRAFTER’S NOTE:**

Error: Function paragraph of bill being cured incorrectly stated that § 14-306 of the State Finance and Procurement Article was amended.

Occurred: Chapter 708 (House Bill 1540) of the Acts of 1990.

**Chapter 594 of the Acts of 1990**

SECTION 9. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act does not apply to employees of the State in the performance of their professional duties as specified in the Annotated Code of Maryland.

**DRAFTER’S NOTE:**

Error: Title of bill being cured failed to give notice of a provision exempting certain State employees from the provisions of the Act.

Occurred: Chapter 594 (House Bill 685) of the Acts of 1990.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the Drafter’s Notes contained in this Act are not law and may not be considered to have been enacted as part of this Act.

SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act is an emergency measure, is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health and safety, has been passed by a ye and nay vote supported by three-fifths of all the members elected to each of the two Houses of the General Assembly, and shall take effect from the date it is enacted.
