(A) (1) THE SECRETARY, THE JAIL BOARD OF THE BALTIMORE CITY JAIL, AND THE CITY OF BALTIMORE SHALL ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 1991 FOR THE PURPOSE OF TRANSFERRING ALL THE RIGHTS, TITLE, AND INTERESTS OF THE PROPERTY, ASSETS, LICENSES, ~~CREDITS, AND RIGHTS~~ AND CREDITS OF THE BALTIMORE CITY JAIL OR ANY PROPERTY OR OTHER ASSETS USED OR ACQUIRED FOR THE BALTIMORE CITY CORRECTIONAL FACILITY TO THE SECRETARY, TO BE USED FOR THE BALTIMORE CITY DETENTION CENTER, OR AS OTHERWISE DIRECTED OR AUTHORIZED BY THE SECRETARY.

(2) THE ASSETS AND PROPERTY SHALL INCLUDE, BUT ARE NOT LIMITED TO:

- (I) THE JAIL INDUSTRIES BUILDING;
- (II) THE GRAVES STREET WORK RELEASE CENTER;
- (III) THE BALTIMORE CITY JAIL ADMINISTRATION BUILDING;
