- (3) Submits to the Commissioner a renewal application on the form that the Commissioner requires; and
- (4) Files a bond or bond continuation certificate for the amount required under § 11-508 of this subtitle.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1991.

CHAPTER 67

(Senate Bill 16)

AN ACT concerning

For Profit Group Homes and Institutions - Foster Care Placement

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- (a) (1) The Department shall provide for the care, diagnosis, training, education, and rehabilitation of children by placing them in group homes and institutions that are operated by FOR-PROFIT OR nonprofit charitable corporations.
- (2) ANY GROUP HOME UTILIZED UNDER THE PROVISIONS OF THIS SECTION SHALL COMPLY WITH THE PROVISIONS OF §§ 5–507 THROUGH 5–509 OF THIS SUBTITLE.
