advisability of allowing group homes and institutions that are operated by not-for-profit charitable organizations to earn revenue in excess of expenses equal to the percentage of profit allowed for in the rates for for-profit corporations if the revenue allowed to be retained by the not-for-profit charitable organization is used in subsequent years for expenditures authorized by the Department's allowable cost policy.

SECTION 2. 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1991.

## State Anatomy Board - Fees
