REPOSITORY OF THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC SAFETY AND CORRECTIONAL SERVICES PAYMENT FOR THE COSTS OF THE FOR A CRIMINAL BACKGROUND CHECK FOR EACH APPLICANT AND EMPLOYEE TO DETERMINE THE EXISTENCE OF A FEDERAL OR STATE CRIMINAL RECORD.

- (2) As a condition of receiving a background investigation [from the Maryland State Police], the Secretary shall submit a complete set of fingerprints of each applicant and of each employee of the applicant to determine the existence of a federal or State criminal history record.
- (b) The [State Police] CRIMINAL JUSTICE INFORMATION SYSTEM CENTRAL REPOSITORY shall investigate the background of each applicant and each employee of the applicant and shall report the results of the investigation to the Secretary. The [State Police] CRIMINAL JUSTICE INFORMATION SYSTEM CENTRAL REPOSITORY shall inform the Secretary of the conviction of any applicant or licensee, or any employee of the applicant or licensee, of a felony, theft offense, or crime of moral turpitude.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1991.
