(b) (1) On or before April [1st] 1 in each [and every] year the County Commissioners of Dorchester County may [allocate and] pay [over] to the Cambridge, Maryland, Hospital, Inc., a sum [in the discretion of] SET BY the County Commissioners. [from time to time, except that in no event may they allocate and pay over to the hospital a sum greater than one half the net profits arising from the operation of the dispensary. Said hospital shall use said funds for the repair or expansion of the hospital buildings, for the establishment and maintenance of a nurse's training school, for the purchase or replacement of necessary equipment or to meet current operation expenses or deficits.]

(2) THE HOSPITAL SHALL USE THE FUNDS FOR:

(I) THE REPAIR OR EXPANSION OF THE HOSPITAL BUILDINGS; AND

(II) THE PURCHASE OR REPLACEMENT OF NECESSARY EQUIPMENT; OR

(III) CURRENT OPERATING EXPENSES OR DEFICITS.

(3) Any sum from [said] THE net proceeds [over and] above that paid to the hospital in each [and every] year shall be credited by the County Commissioners of Dorchester County to a special fund and, thereafter, used only for payments of the principal and/or interest on any bonds or other certificates of indebtedness which are outstanding and payable by the Board of County Commissioners of Dorchester County.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1991.
