- 1. a parent of the minor or a person standing in the place of the parent consents in writing; and
- 2. for hazardous work in a volunteer fire department or company or volunteer rescue squad, the minor:
 - A. is at least 16 years old; and
- B. has completed or is taking a course of study about fire fighting or rescue.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 1991.

CHAPTER 110

(Senate Bill 287)

AN ACT concerning

Baltimore City - 1991 Municipal Election

FOR the purpose of eliminating inconsistencies in certain deadlines for the Baltimore City Primary Election of 1991, and generally relating to deadlines in conducting this election.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article 33 - Election Code-

5–2.

- (b) (1) The day for holding primary elections for municipal offices in Baltimore City shall be on the second Tuesday after the first Monday in September of the year in which the municipal elections in the City of Baltimore are to be held.
- (2) (I) Notwithstanding the provisions of paragraph (1) of this subsection, the day for holding primary elections for municipal offices in Baltimore City in 1991 shall be on the second Thursday after the first Monday in September, 1991.
