necessary for the welfare of the inhabitants of the County, shall be liberally construed to effect its purposes. All Acts and parts of Acts inconsistent with the provisions of this Act are hereby repealed to the extent of any inconsistency.

SECTION 10. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1991.

CHAPTER 124

(House Bill 34)

AN ACT concerning

Vehicle Laws - Special Registration Plates - Disabled Individuals - Parking Privileges

FOR the purpose of authorizing a <u>disabled</u> person for whom special disabled person's registration plates have been issued to park in a space equipped with a parking meter <u>without paying the meter fee</u> for an unlimited period of time twice the maximum time permitted on the parking meter up to a certain maximum time; and generally relating to parking privileges for disabled persons.

 - (vii) Class J (vanpool) vehicles;
