### 1991 LAWS OF MARYLAND

Chapter 342 of the Acts of the General Assembly of 1990 Section 2.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

#### Article - Education

4-106.

(f) (3) Each member of the county board of the counties specified in this paragraph shall receive the enumerated amounts annually for traveling and other expenses.

## (viii) Talbot County:

- 3. Travel ......\$300; and
- 4. Other expenses for each meeting, other than the annual meeting attended on behalf of the county ......\$25.

# Chapter 342 of the Acts of 1990

[SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That, pursuant to Article III, Section 35 of the Constitution of Maryland, this Act may not be construed to extend or apply to the salary or compensation of the Talbot County Board of Education members in office on the effective date of this Act, but the provisions of this Act concerning the salary or compensation of the Talbot County Board of Education members shall take effect at the beginning of the next following term of office.]

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1991.
