SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article - Natural Resources

10-415.

- (c) (1) Every person killing a deer shall report with the deer to a designated checking station within 24 hours after killing the deer.
- (2) Notwithstanding any requirement of law, if the designated checking stations are closed in the county where a person kills a deer, a Natural Resources police officer [may] SHALL authorize the person to report with the deer to a designated checking station in another county.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1991.
