SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article - Transportation

13-616.1.

- (e) (1) A disabled person's parking permit shall be issued in the form of a [windshield] placard HUNG FROM THE REARVIEW MIRROR of a size and design as determined by the Administration. VEHICLES NOT EQUIPPED WITH A REARVIEW MIRROR, OR THOSE IN WHICH THE REARVIEW MIRROR IS NOT VISIBLE FROM THE REAR OF THE VEHICLE, MAY USE A WINDSHIELD PLACARD.
 - (e) (1) A DISABLED PERSON'S PARKING PERMIT SHALL BE ISSUED:
- (I) EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN ITEM (II) OF THIS PARAGRAPH, IN THE FORM OF A PLACARD CAPABLE OF BEING HUNG FROM THE INSIDE REARVIEW MIRROR AND OF A SIZE AND DESIGN AS DETERMINED BY THE ADMINISTRATION; OR
- (II) FOR A VEHICLE NOT EQUIPPED WITH AN INSIDE REARVIEW MIRROR OR IN WHICH THE INSIDE REARVIEW MIRROR IS NOT VISIBLE FROM THE REAR OF THE VEHICLE, IN THE FORM OF A WINDSHIELD PLACARD OF A SIZE AND DESIGN AS DETERMINED BY THE ADMINISTRATION.
 - (2) The placard shall contain the following information:
 - (i) The permit number;
 - (ii) The name and signature of the issuing authority;
- (iii) The designation "Disabled Person's Parking Permit" displayed within the international wheelchair symbol;
 - (iv) The date of expiration; and
 - (v) Any other pertinent information the Administration requires.
- (3) A person to whom a disabled person's parking permit is issued shall display the placard described in this section in:
 - (i) A Class A (passenger) vehicle or a Class M (multipurpose) vehicle;
- (ii) A Class E (truck) vehicle with a 3/4 ton or less manufacturer's rated capacity and specially equipped for the transportation of or operation by a handicapped individual; or
