Article 20 - Public Local Laws of Maryland (1988 Edition, as amended)

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article 20 - Somerset County

2-304.

- (a) The County Commissioners shall appropriate and levy annually [\$109,200] \$152,000 for the use of the organized volunteer fire companies in the County. The sum shall be divided into [6] 7 parts and paid annually to the treasurers of the following companies:
 - (1) Crisfield Volunteer Fire Company, [\$27,000] \$36,000;
 - (2) Princess Anne Volunteer Fire Company, [\$27,000] \$36,000;
 - (3) Marion Volunteer Fire Company, [\$16,700] \$23,000;
- (4) Deal [Island-Chance] ISLAND Volunteer Fire Company, [\$14,700] \$20,000;
- (5) Ewell Fire Department, Inc., of [Smith's] SMITH Island, [\$11,900] \$16,000; [and]
 - (6) Mount Vernon Volunteer Fire Company, Inc., [\$11,900] \$16,000; AND
 - (7) TYLERTON VOLUNTEER FIRE COMPANY, \$5,000.
- (b) (1) From the money appropriated for each of the fire companies in subsection (a) of this section:
- PARAGRAPH, \$5,000 shall be placed into a capital account by the respective fire companies, and shall be used only for capital expenditures, such as purchasing, operating, and repairing fire apparatus and equipment; AND
- (II) \$1,000 SHALL BE PLACED INTO A CAPITAL ACCOUNT BY THE TYLERTON VOLUNTEER FIRE COMPANY, AND SHALL BE USED ONLY FOR CAPITAL EXPENDITURES, SUCH AS PURCHASING, OPERATING, AND REPAIRING FIRE APPARATUS AND EQUIPMENT.
- (2) Payments may not be made to any company which has any regulations or resolutions limiting the territory within which it will respond to calls.
- (c) Each fire company receiving County funds shall provide an accounting of the expenditures of the funds to the County Commissioners.
- (D) THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS MAY LEVY FOR AND APPROPRIATE FUNDS ANNUALLY FOR EMERGENCY SERVICES PROVIDED
