BY ANY VOLUNTEER FIRE COMPANY OR RESCUE SQUAD IF THE VOLUNTEER FIRE COMPANY OR RESCUE SQUAD IS OPERATED ON A NOT FOR PROFIT BASIS.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1991.
