(D) THE DEPARTMENT MAY ALLOW A COMMERCIAL BANK TO HAVE ACCESS TO PERSONAL PROPERTY RETURNS FOR THE LIMITED PURPOSE OF ASSISTING IN THE COLLECTION OF FILING FEES THROUGH A LOCKBOX SYSTEM.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1991.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article - Business Occupations and Professions

8-305.

- (a) Subject to the provisions of this section, the Board shall waive the examination requirements of this subtitle for an individual who is licensed to provide hearing aid services in another state.
 - (b) The Board may grant a waiver under this section only if the applicant:
 - (1) pays the application fee required under § 8-303 of this subtitle; and
 - (2) provides adequate evidence that the applicant:
 - (i) meets the qualifications otherwise required by this title; and
- (ii) became licensed in the other state after meeting, in that or any other state, requirements that are at least equivalent to the licensing requirements of this State.
