SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

## Article - Environment

7-201.

- (a) In this subtitle the following words have the meanings indicated.
- (k) "Federal act" means the Comprehensive Environmental Response, Compensation, and Liability Act of 1980, AS AMENDED THROUGH JANUARY 1, 1990.
  - (m) [(1) "Hazardous substance" means any substance that:
- (i) Conveys toxic, lethal, or other injurious effects or which causes sublethal alterations to plant, animal, or aquatic life;
  - (ii) May be injurious to human beings; or
  - (iii) Persists in the environment.
- (2) "Hazardous substance" includes any matter identified as a "hazardous substance" by the Environmental Protection Agency.] "HAZARDOUS SUBSTANCE" MEANS ANY SUBSTANCE:
- (1) DEFINED AS A HAZARDOUS SUBSTANCE UNDER § 101(14) OF THE FEDERAL ACT; OR
- (2) IDENTIFIED AS A CONTROLLED HAZARDOUS SUBSTANCE BY THE DEPARTMENT IN THE CODE OF MARYLAND REGULATIONS.
- (s) "Release" means the addition, introduction, leaking, spilling, emitting, discharging, escaping, or leaching of any [controlled] hazardous substance into the environment.
  - (x) (1) "Responsible person" means any person who:
- (i) Is the [nongovernmental] owner or operator of a vehicle or a site containing a [controlled] hazardous substance;
