

liquor license, except by way of renewal, may not be granted, transferred, or issued to, or for use in conjunction with, or upon the premises of any business establishment of the type commonly known as chain stores, supermarkets, or discount houses. This subsection does not apply to or affect any business establishment already holding such a license or the possibility of such licensee having the license transferred to a similar type of business establishment. Discount houses do not include licensees who sell at discount prices.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall apply to supermarkets that on January 1, 1990 held a license under Article 2B, § 41(a-1).

SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1991.

(House Bill 193)

AN ACT concerning

Vehicle Laws – Special Registration Plates – ~~Congressional~~ Medal of Honor Recipients

FOR the purpose of providing for the issuance by the Motor Vehicle Administration of certain special registration plates to recipients of the ~~Congressional~~ Medal of Honor; prescribing certain classes of vehicles that may be eligible to display special registration plates issued under this Act; requiring an applicant for special registration plates under this Act to provide certain information to the Administration; establishing a certain fee to be used for a certain purpose; providing for the design of special registration plates issued under this Act; providing that the Administration is not required to reclaim or reissue registration plates until the regular expiration of certain plates; and generally relating to the issuance and display of certain registration plates.
