each fiscal year, one third <u>THEREAFTER</u>, <u>ONE-FIFTH</u> of the General Fund appropriation for the Commission.}

- (e) The total user fees assessed by the Commission shall be equal to [twice the net State contribution. The total user fees assessed by the Commission may not exceed \$2,500,000 in any fiscal year] THE GENERAL FUND APPROPRIATION OF THE COMMISSION.
- (c) (1) THE TOTAL USER FEES ASSESSED BY THE COMMISSION MAY NOT EXCEED \$2,500,000 IN ANY FISCAL YEAR.
- (2) SUBJECT TO THE PROVISIONS OF PARAGRAPH (1) OF THIS SUBSECTION, FOR FISCAL YEAR 1992 THE TOTAL USER FEES ASSESSED BY THE COMMISSION SHALL BE EQUAL TO THE GENERAL FUND APPROPRIATION FOR THE COMMISSION.
- (3) SUBJECT TO THE PROVISIONS OF PARAGRAPH (1) OF THIS SUBSECTION, FOR FISCAL YEAR 1993 AND EACH FISCAL YEAR THEREAFTER THE TOTAL USER FEES ASSESSED BY THE COMMISSION SHALL BE EQUAL TO 4 TIMES THE NET STATE CONTRIBUTION.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1991.

(House Bill 279)

## Estates and Trusts - Termination of Small Trusts

FOR the purpose of authorizing the termination by corporate trustees of trusts of a certain value without a court order under certain circumstances; requiring a corporate trustee proposing to terminate a trust under this Act to send notice to certain persons; establishing procedures for objecting to the termination of a trust; providing for the manner of distribution of a trust estate terminated under this Act; providing that certain provisions in the governing instrument under which a trust was created may not prevent termination under this Act; requiring certain expenses to be borne by the trust estate; requiring a distribution to a minor beneficiary to be made to a certain person; providing for the construction and application of this Act; prohibiting the termination of a trust under certain circumstances; and generally relating to the termination of certain trusts.
