CHAPTER 178

(House Bill 329)

AN ACT concerning

Mental Health – Core Service Agencies

FOR the purpose of establishing core service agencies to coordinate the delivery of certain mental health services; requiring core service agencies to submit a program plan to the Secretary of Health and Mental Hygiene for approval; providing for certain advisory committees; providing that the Secretary shall define certain priority populations to be served; specifying that the Secretary may not require a core service agency to provide certain services under certain circumstances; requiring a certain report by a certain date; defining certain terms; and generally relating to core service agencies for mental health services.

Section 10-1201 through 10-1203 to be under the new subtitle “Subtitle 12. Core Service Agencies”

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article – Health – General

SUBTITLE 12. CORE SERVICE AGENCIES

10-1201.

(A) IN THIS SUBTITLE THE FOLLOWING WORDS HAVE THE MEANINGS INDICATED.

(B) “CORE SERVICE AGENCY” MEANS THE ~~CENTRAL~~ DESIGNATED COUNTY OR MULTICOUNTY AUTHORITY THAT IS RESPONSIBLE FOR PLANNING, MANAGING, AND MONITORING PUBLICLY FUNDED MENTAL HEALTH SERVICES.
