(M) ANY PERSON WHO IS CONVICTED OF A VIOLATION OF ANY OF THE PROVISIONS OF § 21–802.1 OF THIS ARTICLE (ESTABLISHMENT OF SPEED LIMITS WITHIN HIGHWAY WORK ZONES) (EXCEEDING SPEED LIMIT WITHIN HIGHWAY WORK ZONE) IS SUBJECT TO A FINE OF AT LEAST \$250 BUT NOT MORE THAN \$1,000.
