

COMMISSIONERS MAY BUILD, LEASE, PURCHASE, OR OTHERWISE ESTABLISH AND OPERATE PUBLIC MARKETS IN THE COUNTY.

(B) (1) THE COUNTY MAY NOT ESTABLISH A MARKET WITHIN THE BOUNDARIES OF ANY MUNICIPAL CORPORATION IN THE COUNTY.

(2) IF A MARKET ESTABLISHED BY THE COUNTY IS OPERATING ON LAND THAT IS SUBSEQUENTLY ANNEXED BY A MUNICIPAL CORPORATION, THE COUNTY MAY CONTINUE TO OPERATE THE MARKET.

(C) THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS MAY ADOPT REGULATIONS TO CARRY OUT THIS SECTION.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1991.

CHAPTER 193

(House Bill 424)

AN ACT concerning

Carroll County – Carroll County General Hospital – Appropriation

FOR the purpose of authorizing the County Commissioners of Carroll County to appropriate a certain amount each fiscal year for a certain ~~period~~ number of fiscal years to Carroll County General Hospital, Inc. for capital improvements; and clarifying the authority of the County Commissioners to tax assessable property in the County to fund the appropriation.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article 7 – Carroll County
