

BEGINNING JULY 1, 1992, TO the Carroll County General Hospital, Inc. FOR CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS. The County Commissioners [also] may levy annually and collect from the assessable property in Carroll County, as other County taxes are levied and collected, [such] THE amount [as may be] necessary for this appropriation.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1991.

**CHAPTER 194**  
**(House Bill 429)**

AN ACT concerning

**Frederick County – Solid Waste Systems – Bonding Authority**

FOR the purpose of authorizing and empowering the County Commissioners of Frederick County to borrow money in order to finance the costs of certain solid waste systems in Frederick County, and to effect such borrowing by the issuing and sale of certain bonds, consistent with the county's existing bond authority concerning water, sewerage, and drainage systems; authorizing the County Commissioners to make general fund appropriations and borrow money relating to the engineering and construction of needed solid waste systems; providing that certain powers, duties, functions, and limitations concerning water, sewerage, and drainage systems also apply to solid waste systems; providing that certain bonds, for purposes of issuance and sale, may be consolidated into a single issue with other bonds that the County Commissioners may issue; defining certain terms; making stylistic changes; and generally relating to the bonding authority and to solid waste systems of Frederick County.

BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,

The Public Local Laws of Frederick County

Section 2-13-1, 2-13-3(d)(4) and (5), 2-13-4, 2-13-5, 2-13-6(a), 2-13-9(a), 2-13-10, 2-13-11(a), 2-13-12, 2-13-13(a) and (b), 2-13-14(a), 2-13-17, and 2-13-23(c) to be under the amended chapter "Chapter 2-13 Water, Sewers, Drains, and Solid Waste"
