Water, Sewers, [and] Drains, AND SOLID WASTE

- (A) In this chapter, the following words have the meanings [indicated:] INDICATED.
 - (B) Board means the board of county commissioners.
- (C) Bonds means notes, bonds, and other evidences of indebtedness or obligations.
- (D) Commission means the Frederick County Metropolitan Commission created by Chapter 609 of the Acts of 1968, the powers and functions of which have been transferred to the county by an action of the board pursuant to Section 2–2–23 of this Code.
- (E) County means board of county commissioners of Frederick County, a body politic and corporate of the State of Maryland.
- (F) (1) Drainage system means all plants, systems, facilities, or properties, and all properties, rights, easements, and franchises relating thereto and deemed necessary or convenient by the board for the operation thereof, used or useful or having the present capacity for future use in connection with:
- [(1)] (I) The collection, control, distribution, carrying away, or disposal of surface waters, and any integral part thereof, including (without limitation) storm water drainage;
- [(2)] (II) The prevention and control of erosion, and any integral part thereof; and
- [(3)] (III) The management and control of sedimentation, and any integral part thereof.
- (2) "Drainage system" does not include drainage facilities which are part of a water system or sewerage system and which are not part of a system having the primary purpose of draining surface waters.
- (G) Frederick County means the geographic area within the corporate limits of Frederick County.
- (H) Project means any water system, sewerage system, drainage system, OR SOLID WASTE SYSTEM, and any combination or part or parts thereof owned, constructed, or operated by the county under the provisions of this chapter.
- (I) Service area means the area within Frederick County in which the board may exercise power and authority under this chapter in accordance with the provisions of section 2-13-5 of this chapter.
- (J) Sewage means the water-carried wastes created in and carried, or to be carried, away from residences, hotels, schools, hospitals, industrial establishments,
