

(d) (1) The Department may provide by regulation for issuance of special Chesapeake Bay sport fishing licenses, which shall authorize fishing by the special licensee for a stated period of time, not to exceed 3 consecutive days. The fee for each license issued shall be \$2.

(c) (1) Any person desiring to catch crabs in the waters of the State for noncommercial purposes by using a trotline in excess of 500 feet first shall obtain a license.

(2) Only one occupant on a boat used to catch crabs for noncommercial purposes shall be required to have a license. The daily catch of the boat shall be limited to 2 bushels per licensee.

(3) A person holding a commercial crabber's license to catch crabs for sale may catch crabs for noncommercial purposes in accordance with the provisions of this section without paying the fee for noncommercial crabbing.

(4) A person may not set or fish a trotline or collapsible crab trap within 50 feet of a trotline.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That each person who obtains a tidal fish license to catch crabs for noncommercial purposes under § 4-804(c) of the Natural Resources Article for the license year beginning September 1, 1991 may continue to catch crabs for noncommercial purposes until December 31, 1992 at no additional charge.

SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1991.
