SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article - Business Occupations and Professions

7-306.

(a) If an applicant qualifies for a license under this subtitle, the Board shall mail the applicant a notice that states that:

(1) the applicant has qualified for a license;

(2) on receipt of a [~~\$30~~] \$55 license fee, the Board will issue a license to the applicant; and

(3) if the applicant fails to pay the license fee within 30 days after receipt of the notice, the applicant forfeits the right to be issued a license and, to obtain a license, may be required to submit a new application and to pay a new application fee.

(c) Before a license expires, the licensee periodically may renew it for an additional 2-year term, if the licensee:

(1) otherwise is entitled to be licensed;

(2) except as provided in subsection (d) of this section, pays to the Board a renewal fee of [~~\$75~~] \$100; and

(3) submits to the Board a renewal application on the form that the Board provides.

(a) If an applicant qualifies for a license under this subtitle, the Board shall send the applicant a notice that states that:

(1) the applicant has qualified for a license; and

(2) on receipt of a [~~\$100~~] \$250 license fee, the Board will issue a license to the applicant.
